
Dear Mr. Carpenter:

As you may be aware, in 2015 the merger between American Airlines, Inc. ("American") and US Airways was finalized. In evaluating our needs and capabilities with respect to our reciprocal travel agreement program, unfortunately, we are unable to continue to offer reciprocal travel agreement privileges to Amerijet. Pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, either party may terminate the Agreement at any time by providing thirty (30) days' written notice. This letter shall serve as formal written notice to Amerijet of American's termination of the Agreement, effective as of May 1, 2016.
